CHANGES

Schreiner University reserves the right to modify or update these rules at any time.

RESERVATION TRANSFERS

Reservations can be transferred to a different person until March 15, 2024. To transfer a reservation, contact us. Only registered guests are allowed in dorm rooms and assigned stay locations. A \$50.00 transfer fee is required upon transferring the reservation.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OR PARTIAL REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING CANCELLATIONS, NO-SHOWS, LATE ARRIVALS, ILLNESS, FAMILY EMERGENCIES, INCLEMENT WEATHER, OR EARLY DEPARTURES REGARDLESS OF CIRCUMSTANCE.

This is an astronomical event that will happen regardless of weather or other circumstances.

CHECK-IN PROCESS

04/08/24 Parking Pass Guests campus gates will be unlocked at 7:00am Check-in is available from 7:00am. We strongly recommend arriving before 10:00am.

Overnight Guests must register at Schreiner Outfitters Campus store, located at the CCAC building to obtain stay assignments. All fees must be paid upon booking apartments.

VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS

Only one vehicle is allowed for each registered stay.

PARKING RULES

Participants must follow Schreiner University's parking regulations and only park in designated areas for the Event. Parking offenders may receive tickets from Schreiner University Security.

SPEED LIMIT ON CAMPUS

A 20-mph speed limit on main roads and a 15-mph on residential parking logs is enforced throughout the campus to ensure pedestrian safety. Reckless or fast drivers will be asked to vacate the premises.

CHILD SUPERVISION

Parents or guardians must supervise and maintain responsibility for their children at all times.

CONDUCT GUIDELINES

Neither individuals nor service animals are allowed to disturb the peace or create unreasonable noise levels.

PETS

Pets are not authorized in university housing. To have live animals on site during the event, written approval must be requested at least 30 days before the event. Service animals such as dogs trained to assist individuals with disabilities are exempt from this requirement. Pets must be leashed at all times, waste bags must be used, and animals cannot be left unattended or tied up outside.

RESTROOM FACILITIES

Portable restrooms and handwashing stations will be available across the campus.

SPACE MAINTENANCE

University apartments should remain clean and organized. An onsite dumpster is available for waste disposal. Participants are expected to dispose of trash in designated areas as outlined by Schreiner University. If spaces require excessive cleaning, participants will be billed for additional service hours. Please refrain from pouring any substances (including water and ice) on flowerbeds or grass areas.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

It is the participants' responsibility to remove all personal belongings from their assigned space before the end of the event. Unclaimed items after seven days may be retained, disposed of, or trashed by Schreiner University, at its discretion, and without obligation, or liability of any kind or nature to the participant.

FOOD AND DRINK

Participants can bring their own food, beverages, and coolers to the event. Food and beverage vendors will be present at the Trailhead. Unauthorized sale of food and beverage is prohibited without prior approval through Schreiner University Event Services.

PROPERTY DAMAGE

Participants and guests found intentionally, or negligently damaging campus property or equipment will be held responsible for repairs or replacement. Schreiner University must be reimbursed for all reasonable costs associated with fixing or replacing damaged property.

CAMPFIRES

Open campfires are not allowed. Participants cannot use propane or open flames during the event or on university premises.

TOBACCO USE POLICY

Smoking, vape pens and smokeless or chewing tobacco use are prohibited on all University owned and leased properties.

VIOLENCE

Any acts or threats of violence are not tolerated.

STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Storing hazardous materials on campus is not allowed.

WEAPONS

Schreiner University is a weapons free campus. Neither open or concealed carry is permitted.

DRUGS

Possessing, selling, or manufacturing illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia on campus is strictly forbidden.

ALCOHOL

Alcohol consumption is restricted to designated areas established by Schreiner University. These designated areas aim to create a controlled and secure environment.

UNIVERSITY RIGHT TO PREMISES

Schreiner University reserves the right to require identification from any person on campus, deny entry to those without legitimate business on campus, and remove anyone violating laws or University rules. Participants must cooperate with all authorized University agents in exercising these rights.

ANY GUEST FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THESE RULES MAY BE ASKED TO VACATE CAMPUS, WITHOUT REFUND.
