On October 7, 2021, Donald Crandall performed Sergei Rachmaninoff's Rhapsody on a Theme by Paganini with the Symphony of the Hills Orchestra at the Cailloux Theatre.

Graced with a full house of loyal patrons, community members, and business sponsors, including Chris Cheever who sponsored that evening's concert, my performance was received with high accolades including an unexpected standing ovation and curtain calls. More importantly, however, was the opportunity to perform this major work for two Children's Concerts at the Cailloux Theatre the day before the public concert.

Approximately 1,600 students from the Texas Hill Country attended and I was allowed to share this prodigious musical composition with the youth in



our community as part of the Symphony's annual academic musical outreach program.

For those who are not familiar with the composition itself, Rachmaninoff's Rhapsody on a Theme by Paganini is a dynamic and complex concerto that challenges any pianist both technically and musically. There are 24 variations, and these are based on Paganini's 24th Caprice For Solo Violin.

One of the biggest undertakings in performing this piece is the extreme physical demands found in the 24 variations. Along with the virtuosic intensity of the piano score, being able to synchronize intricate rhythms with the orchestra to maintain metrical accuracy is also essential.

I feel blessed to have been asked by Dr. Eugene Dowdy and our Symphony Board of Directors to perform such a work, and I am proud of our shared achievement.
