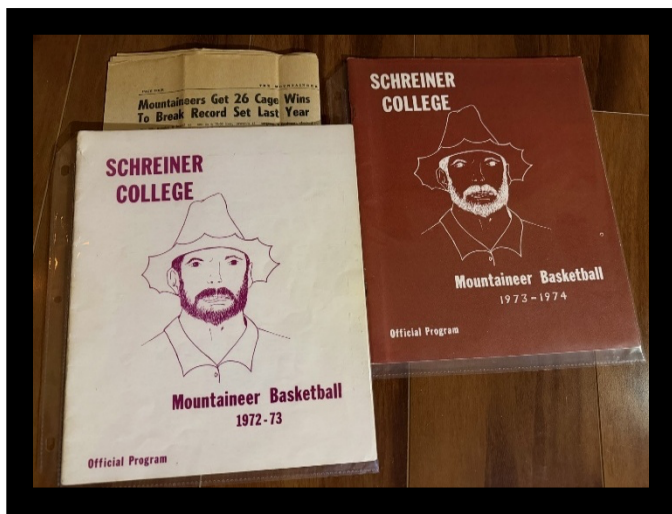

Thank you Dru for all you do for your community! We are so proud of you!

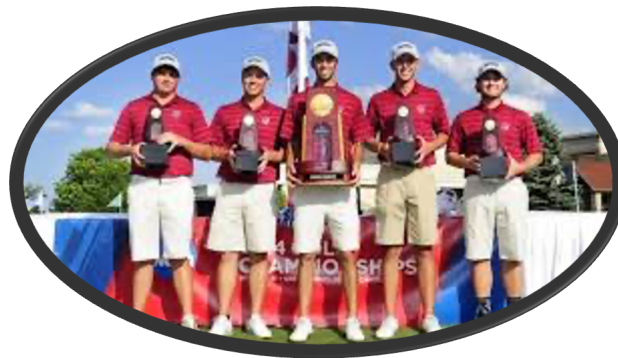

YES you are Kendalls! She is perfect, and so very loved. (Does she already have her first 7-Iron?!)

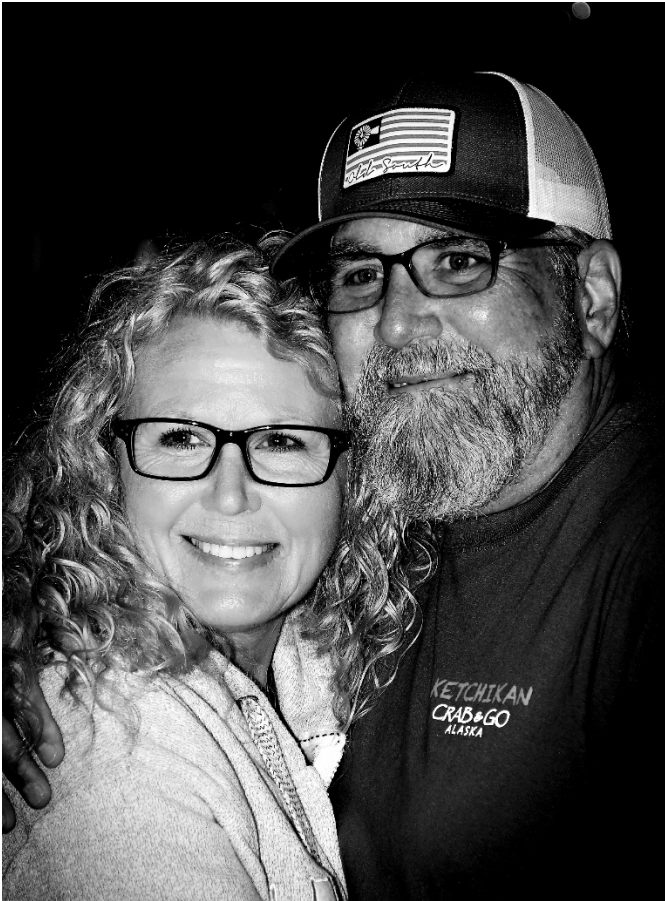


Cheyne was on Schreiner's National Championship Golf Team in 2014.
