## Vocational Nursing Program Application Process

Application deadline for the January 2020 Vocational Nursing Program is  
**September 1st, 2019.**

1. **Application** submitted online or on the paper application
2. **Application fee-** \$25 (non-refundable)
3. **Essay-** why you want to be a nurse; the steps taken to make sure the one-year commitment to the VN Program can be fulfilled; the academic record from high school and/or college; and where you hope this education will lead you over the next 10 years. Also include hobbies and volunteer work or any other information you think is relevant.
4. **Official High School Transcript** or Official GED Scores
5. **Official College Transcripts** from all colleges attended (if any)
  - Students who have at least 15 credit hours of college-level credit with a 2.0 GPA, including college math and English, may be exempt from a required entrance exam. The Admission Committee makes the exemption decision.
6. **Two Reference Letters** completed by a current or former employer or person (not a friend or relative) who can give a character and performance evaluation. These can be mailed to the Admissions Office or emailed to the Admissions Counselor.
7. **An assessment in Math and English** is required. This requirement can be met by:
  - Having College Algebra and English
  - Submitting scores from SAT, ACT, THEA, TSI or Accuplacer.
    - See Entrance Exam requirements for scores required on each exam
8. **Background check through the Texas Board of Nursing** is required. Schreiner will send your information to the BON who will email you instructions for completing the fingerprinting for the background check process.
9. **Drug testing** is required on the day of the interview, to be purchased through CastleBranch.

Students who complete all of the above requirements will be scheduled for personal interviews with the nursing faculty. After interviews have been completed, usually by October, you will be notified of the admissions decision. Admitted students will then receive information on submitting the remaining requirements for the program.
