This is a suggested list of items designed to help you decide what to bring to campus. Keep in mind the space you will be moving to. Packing light will help make it easier to keep your room clean, free of clutter and easier to move in and out.

## BED AND BATH

- Extra-Long Twin Sheets
- Comforter or Blanket
- Mattress Pad
- Pillow(s) and Pillowcases
- K-cup Coffee Pot
- Mini fridge (4.3 cubic feet or smaller)
- Microwave (0.7 cubic feet or smaller)
- Small Trash Can Bags
- Small Area Rug
- Clothes & Clothes Hangers
- Shower Curtain and Rings (not needed in Delaney)
- Shower Caddy
- Shower Shoes or Flip Flops
- Towels & Robe

## IDENTIFICATION & MONEY

- Debit Card/ Credit Card
- Driver License/ ID
- Insurance Cards (Medical, Dental, etc.)
- Renters Insurance
- Social Security Card
- Passport/Visa
- Small Lock Box

## ELECTRONICS

- Cell Phone & Charger
- Computer or Laptop, Laptop Charger
- Gaming System
- Power Strip with Surge Protector
- TV & Streaming Device (Roku, Amazon Fire Stick, etc.)

## LAUNDRY SUPPLIES

- High-Efficiency (HE) Laundry Detergent
- Dryer Sheets
- Laundry Bag or Basket

## CLEANING SUPPLIES

- Small broom and dustpan
- Bathroom cleaner with bleach
- Windex, Multipurpose Cleaner
- Paper Towels
- Drain Snake Hair Clog Remover Tool

## PERSONAL HYGIENE & TOILETRIES

- Soap, Shampoo, Hair Products, Hair Dryer
- Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Floss
- Toilet Paper
- Prescription Medications
- Makeup, Moisturizers, Hairbrush
- First Aid Kit, Thermometer
- Shaving Accessories

## MISCELLANEOUS

- Memento's from home
- Backpack & School Supplies- Pens, pencils, mini stapler, notebooks, calculator, folders, weekly planner, USB drives, highlighters, etc.
- Lanyard or keychain for room keys and ID
- 3M™ Command™ Strips for posters
- Message Board (Dry erase board)
- Flashlight with batteries
- Umbrella and Raingear

## DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS TO CAMPUS

Here are some items that are prohibited and cannot be brought to campus. **This is a partial list.**

- Wax/fragrance warmers, candles, incense, halogen lamps, lava lamps, space heaters, extension cords, cooking appliances (Coffee pots, hot plates, grills, toaster, toaster ovens, etc.), or any items with heating coils. These items are considered fire hazards.
- Air conditioners, ceiling fans, furniture
- Pets (other than fish in 10-gallon tank)
- JUULs, vapes or tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, dip, etc.)
- Alcohol, drugs or drug paraphernalia (this includes "decorative" alcohol bottles and drug-related items)
- Firearms or weapons of any kind
